Summary

Create a new webpage using Komodo (or other editor).

1. The name of this page should be **basic.html**
2. Use at least 5 different tags covered in lecture.
3. Upload to the CS webserver using scp or WinSCP

Assignment

In this assignment you will create your first web page. In subsequent labs you will add to and refine this page and build a multi-page website.

Be sure to have at least two lists in your web page. You will convert them into real lists in Lab 2.

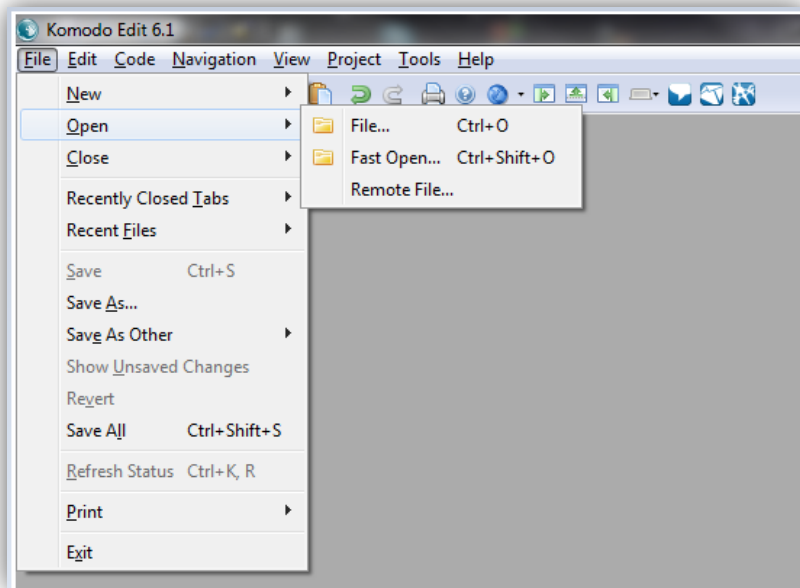
Part 1 – Create and Test the Basic Web Page Setup

1. You can either start from scratch or with an existing webpage. To start from scratch, Open the Komodo editor and from the File menu choose New File. Name your file **basic.html**. Jump to step #6.

To start from an existing webpage, copy the following URL in a browser

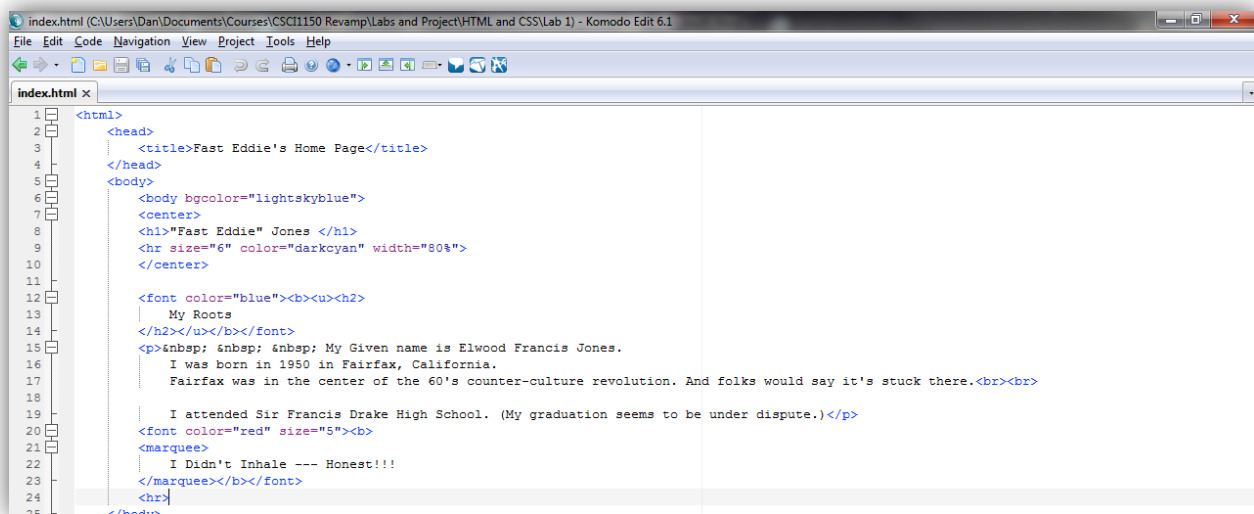
<https://www.cs.mtsu.edu/~hcarroll/1150/tours/webDevelopment/starter.html> and save it as **basic.html** on your USB drive (or other location). The USB drive is highly recommended as you'll be able to continue to work on it after lab and you'll use the results of today's lab in subsequent labs. If you don't have a USB drive email the .html pages to yourself.

2. Open the Komodo editor.
3. Close the Start Page tab, if it appears.
4. In Komodo go to File, Open File.



5. Locate the **basic.html** file and open it up.

What you'll now have in Komodo is the following web page code:



6. Open up the file with Chrome or Firefox (using the **Open with** option) to see what you have as a starting point

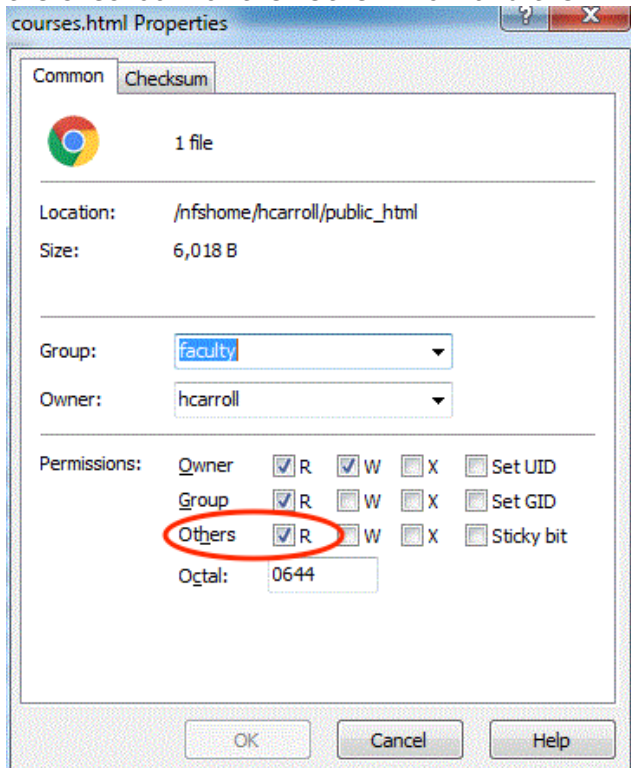

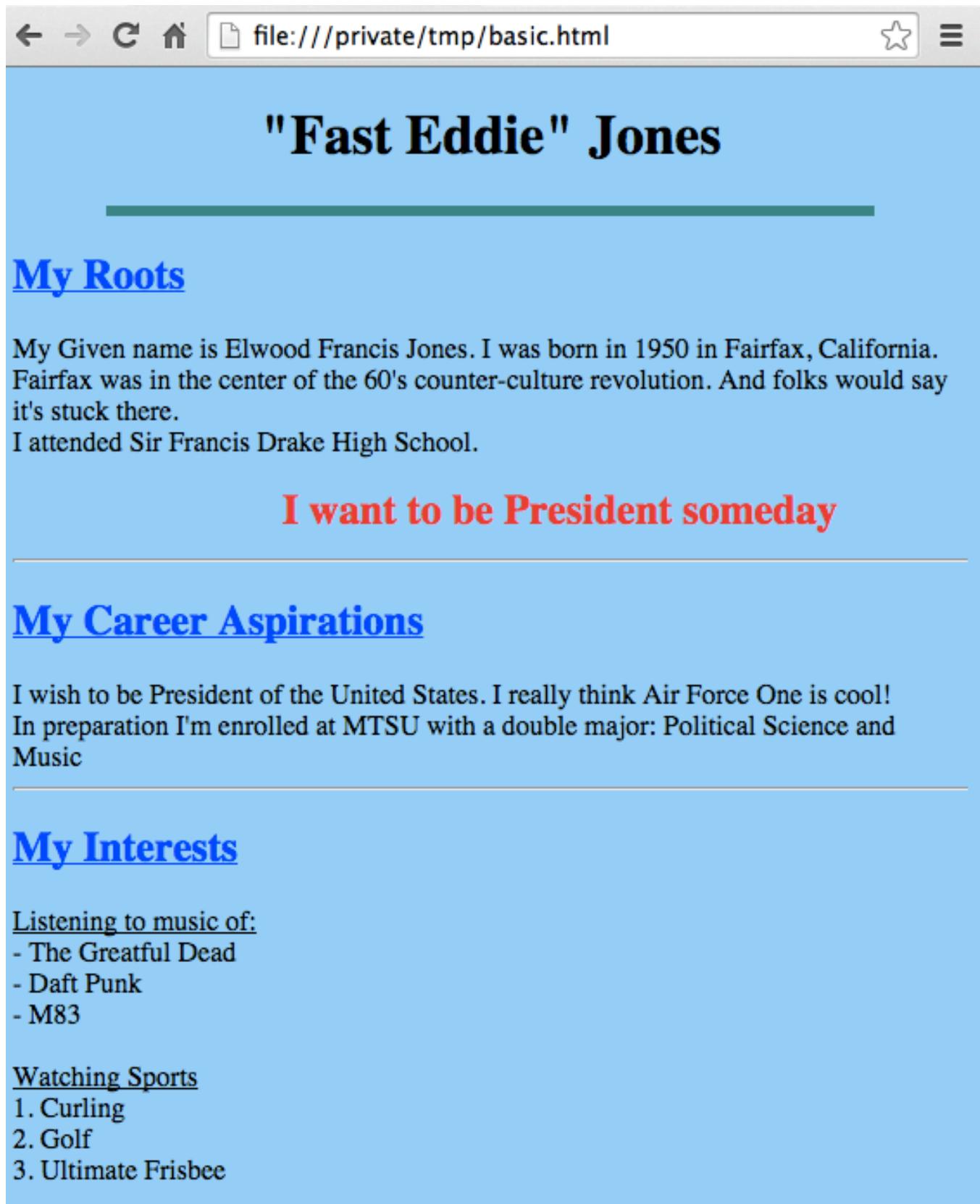
**** This text will be in the chosen color and size. **** will cause the following text to revert to the default font.

Tip: Build your web page incrementally, adding some additional content and tags, then test. Repeat this over and over again adding content or changing something and then view it in a browser again. This will help you more easily identify and correct any errors you make. It's better than adding everything at once.

3. Copy your **basic.html** to your account on the Computer Science webserver using scp or WinScp (https://www.cs.mtsu.edu/~hcarroll/1150/WinSCP_tutorial.pdf).
4. Verify your webpage is available online at:
<https://www.cs.mtsu.edu/~YourPipelineID/basic.html>.
5. If you get an error message that the file is "Forbidden", then you need to change the "read" permissions for "other". You can do this on a mac by typing "chmod 755 basic.html" in a terminal window. Alternatively, you can do this in WinSCP by right-clicking on the file basic.html on the right-hand side (the ranger side) and selecting "Properties". Then make sure the checkbox for the "Other:" row and the "R" (read) column is checked:
