I also understand that the deadline for receiving applications is February 1, 2012.

- Participants will be required to submit a deposit of **\$200** with their application.
- The first additional payment of **\$1760** is due February 1, 2012.
- The remainder of the fee (**\$1760**) must be received by the final deadline of March 1, 2012.
- The airline ticket will be non-refundable and non-transferable. Transient students must pay an additional \$50 fee at the time of application

The Center for International Education will register me for the appropriate study abroad classes. All students who participate in study abroad are required to be enrolled in the relevant class(es) and complete the required course work. **All students must pay tuition and fees in full at least one week prior to departure. CIE will not allow students to participate in a study abroad program if they have not paid all program fees and class tuition. In that case any program fees already paid by the student will be forfeited.**

CSU also has the right to cancel the program due to low enrollments or unforeseen developments. All costs are subject to change because of unanticipated increases in airfares or other program costs, as well as fluctuations in monetary exchange rates. CSU will make every effort to keep program costs as advertised and will inform prospective participants of any changes as they occur.
